English

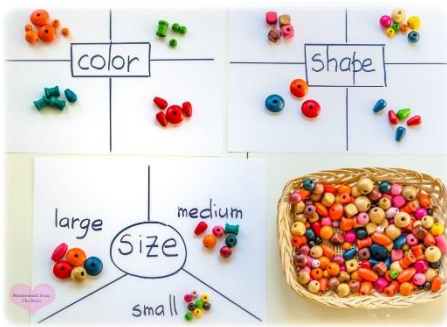
Listen to a story being read. Draw a picture of your favourite character. Describe what they look like and what they do.

In science we are learning about different materials. Search for objects at home made out of


