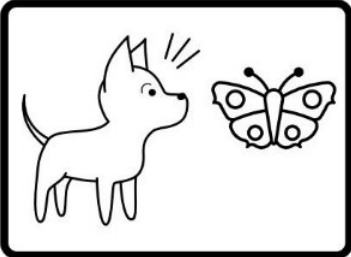
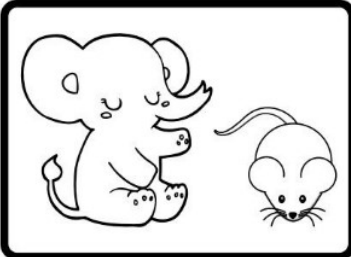
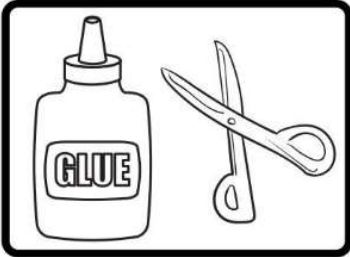
English	Look at a family photo and talk about what was happening, who was there, and why it was special.

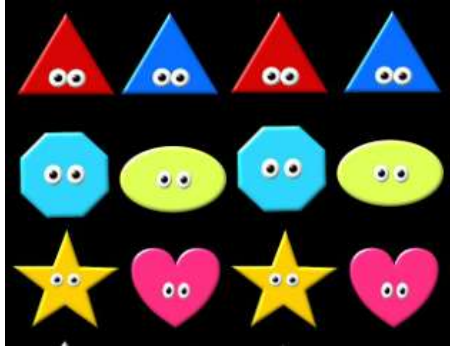
