WEEK 1		
English	Talk with a family member about something fun you did on the weekend. Use words like "first," "then," and "finally."	
Spelling	Tricky words – have, off, here, with Practice writing your tricky words Search for objects around the house that start with 'w' Search for objects around the house that have the 'ck' sound	
Mathematics	Go on a collection hunt (e.g. 5 leaves, 7 buttons, 10 blocks). Count out loud and line them up.	
Science	Look outside. Draw the weather you can see.	
WEEK 2		
English	Draw a picture of something you like doing (e.g. baking, playing). Tell someone what you did and how it made you feel.	
Spelling	Tricky words – all, call, ball, tall, little Practice writing your tricky words Search for objects around the house that have the 'sh' sound Search for objects around the house that have the 'll', 'ff' sound	
Mathematics	Use blocks or LEGO to build towers from 1 to 10. Which one is tallest? Which one is shortest?	
Science	Draw the clothes you would wear on a hot sunny day.	
WEEK 3		
English	Draw a picture of something that happened today. How did it make you feel? Add a word or face to show the feeling.	
Spelling	Tricky words – go, so, no, this, then Practice writing your tricky words Search for objects around the house that have the 'ee' sound Search for objects around the house that have the 'z'/'zz' sound	
Mathematics	Look around the house for shapes (e.g. round plate, square cushion). Say the shape names together.	
Science	Draw the clothes you would wear on a rainy day.	

WEEK 4	
English	After reading a book at home, tell someone what happened in the story—who, where, and what happened first and last.
Spelling	Tricky words – put, as, do Practice writing your tricky words Search for objects around the house that start with 'v' Search for objects around the house that start with 'x' Search for objects around the house that have the 'ch' sound
Mathematics	Use real or pretend items and "buy" them using play money or tokens. Count how many items you get.
Science	Think of all the things you can do on a hot sunny day or a rainy day.

WEEK 5	
English	Draw three things you did today. Try to tell the story in order using words like "morning," "lunch," and "afternoon."
Spelling	Tricky words – like, very Practice writing your tricky words Search for objects around the house that start with 'y'
Mathematics	Use hands, blocks or string to measure the length of your foot, toy or book. Say which is longer or shorter.
Science	Draw the clothes you would need to wear on a cold day. Then draw what you would wear if it got hot. Describe why you need to change your clothes.
